## **GENERAL REMINDERS**

#### School Attendance & Punctuality -

School starts daily at 9:20am for all students and finishes at 3pm. Supervision of students is facilitated by staff from 9:10am each morning in the front and back yards. Please ensure your child is on their line, in time every morning. Any child arriving to the school after 9:20am will require a parent/guardian to sign them in at the front office with Kay/Diane. Punctuality is vitally important each morning and afternoon for drop-off and collection.

As part of our school attendance strategy, if your child is absent from school, please input a reason for their absence using the Aladdin Connect App. Your cooperation with this is greatly appreciated.

#### School Uniform -

The school uniform in San Carlo SNS consists of a navy cotton jumper, navy cotton tracksuit pants and a white polo t-shirt. No bicycle shorts or leggings are permitted as part of the school uniform. If your child wishes to wear shorts to school during spells of better weather, they are permitted to do so, but they should be unbranded, navy shorts. If you require an iron on crest, they are available to be purchased from the school office with Kay or Diane.

#### Medical Conditions/Allergies -

As part of updating the medical profiles of <u>all</u> students within the school community, we are asking you to reach out to Kay/Diane in the office to complete an updated medical form if your child has any medical/health related concerns that we need to be aware of.
